The Sons of Noah, The Tower of Babel

<u>SERMON OUTLINE</u> Title: The Sons of Noah, The Tower of Babel Scripture Passage: Genesis 11:1-9

INTRODUCTION

- The Sons of Noah Genesis 9:18-28
 - Genesis 9:18 recorded the sons of Noah Shem, Ham, Japheth who came out of the ark (Note: Emphasis on Ham, the father of Canaan)
 - Genesis 9:20-28 Curse on Canaan, Blessings on Shem
- The Roots of the Nations Genesis 10:1-32
 - 7 sons of Japheth Genesis 10:2-5
 - 4 sons of Ham Genesis 10:6-20
 - 5 sons of Shem Genesis 10:21-31
- Genesis 10 describes the dispersion of the people (Gen 10:32)

TOWER OF BABEL

• Genesis 11 – provides the reasons why the people were dispersed

Sin of Disobedience:

- Disobeyed God's command in Genesis 9:1 & 7 settling in the land of Shinar is an act of disobedience (Gen 11:1-2)
- Lent Season learn to obey God's Words during our reflection and confession

Sin of Distrust:

- Distrust God by building a city and a tower (Gen 11:3-4a)
- The Tower of Babel an act of rebellion against God
- Why build a city and a tower?

Sin of Pride:

- The men of Shinar were chasing their own glory making a name for themselves, not to glorify God or lift His name (Gen 11:4b)
- The foolishness of pride (Psalm 127:1, Luke 14:28-30)
- God is all-knowing (Gen 11:6)
- The dispersion and origin of languages (Gen 11:7-9)

CONCLUSION

Know: There are no other alternative routes to heaven. Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life.

Be: Obedient to God – Trust and Obey His Words. Walk closely with God.

Do: Away with the sin of pride. Be humble. Remember pride goes before a fall.

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. What is something you **look up** to each day? Your emails, WhatsApp, parents, friends, boss, teachers or God?
- 1. What is something you **look forward to** each day? Your family? Covid-19 to end? Resume travelling overseas? Obey God?
- 2. What are you **chasing** each day name for yourself? Riches, status? Run to Jesus your Tower? Are you chasing after the wind?
