SERMON OUTLINE

Title: Rest so that you can Rebuild

Scripture Passage: 1 Kings 15:9-15, 2 Chronicles 14:4-7

BIG IDEA: We need God's rest to rebuild our lives

Key Verse: 2 Chronicles 14:6 (NIV)

He built up the fortified cities of Judah, since the land was at peace. No one was at war with him during those years, for the Lord gave him rest.

Introduction

- King Asa's heart was devoted to God (1 Kings 15:9-14)
- As he and the people sought the LORD, God gave them rest in the land (2 Chronicles 14:4-7)

Seeking after God's heart helps us to:

1. Rest

Finding our rest in the LORD is not just a priority; it is a necessity.

- God's desire is for His people to dwell safely and in peace in the land (2 Samuel 7:10-11, 1 Kings 5:4)
- But sin and idolatry disrupt God's relationship with people. The people needed to respond to God's call for repentance (for e.g. Isaiah 30:15)
- King Asa led Judah to repent and seek the LORD, and God gave them rest (2 Chronicles 14:2-6)
- Jesus invites us to find our true rest in Him (Matthew 11:28)
- Take-away: Renew our rest in Jesus

2. Rebuild

We can only rebuild successfully when we have God's rest

- God's rest is preparation to rebuild our faith and lives
- King Asa realized that God's rest enable him to rebuild Judah (2 Chronicles 14:7)
- God's rest enables us to rebuild our lives around His faithfulness and to strengthen key relationships that define our lives
- Take-away: Focus on rebuilding your key relationships with the love of Christ

3. Revive

God's heart is to revive the church

- The period of rebuilding and experiencing God's faithfulness and rest enabled Asa to respond to a serious military threat
- As responded with faith and Judah experienced a great deliverance (2 Chronicles 14:9-12)
- God's rest enables the church to be strengthened for a new season of revival and breakthrough (e.g. Acts 9:31)
- Take-away: We must align ourselves to God's heart for revival, and not be engrossed with our own plans
