SERMON OUTLINE

God's Eternal Light and Glory
Isaiah 60:19-22 (NIV)

Isaiah 60 Breakdown

1. Judgment and Warnings - chapters 1-39
2. Hope and Restoration - chapters 40-55
3. New Creation - chapters 56-66

Big Idea: The LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory

God speaks of His creation in the Scriptures, from its beginning, its expansion, its ending and His creation of the new heaven and earth

Our dependency on God wanes as man progresses technologically, pride and self-dependency grow

In the new creation, our new source of light and life will be personal, everlasting and glorious

God, not self, will be our glory

Sorrow will end

The promised land will be possessed forever

God will hasten the coming new creation, but in His time

Conclusion

KNOW: that God will on His day redeem us and He will be our everlasting light.

BE: vigilant and hopeful, and keep the faith even during times of darkness.

DO: seek to glory in God and in Him alone

Discussion Questions

1. How can we do better in our lives to ensure that God will be our glory?
2. What can we do to constantly remind ourselves to depend solely on God and not on ourselves?
3. How can we persevere in faith during dark and difficult times and stay strong in faith that the Lord will be our everlasting light?
