

## **SERMON OUTLINE**

Living as God's Temple  
2 Corinthians 6:16-18

**Big Idea:** Our identity as God's Temple needs to be lived out consistently.

**Key Verse: 2 Corinthians 6:16a (NIV)**

*What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God.*

### **Introduction**

- Pagan temples in Corinth function as religious, social and civic gatherings to strengthen the sense of identity and community within the city.
- There was a debate in the Corinthian church about whether it was permissible for Christians to participate in the meals and functions held within these temples.
- Paul was adamant that Christians should not have anything to do with pagan temple activity; rather, believers must be mindful of their identity as the temple of the living God.

**Living as God's temple means:**

#### **1. Presence with God (2 Cor 6:16)**

- God's dwelling presence is the distinguishing characteristic of God's people (Exodus 33:15-16).
- Our identity must be shaped and forged in God's dwelling presence.

#### **2. Purity in Living (2 Cor 6:17)**

- God's presence compels a distinction between holiness and defilement, clean and unclean, righteousness and wickedness (cf Malachi 3:18).
- Being part of God's temple carries a responsibility of separation from the defiling influence of the world.
- Be separate from the world, without losing effective witness and engagement with the world (John 17:15-18).

#### **3. Family in God's household (2 Cor 6:18)**

- God desires to make us His children, shaped to be like Jesus (Romans 8:14-17, 29).
- Being separate from the world's system of values, status and security does not leave us abandoned.
- Rather, we are loved and secured by God Himself as our Heavenly Father (Matthew 7:9-11, Luke 11:11-13).

**Conclusion:**

Living as God's Temple means that we live aware of God's abiding presence, separate from the influence of the world, and secured as His very own sons and daughters.

**Reflection Questions:**

1. What is one thing you would do this coming week to become more aware of God's abiding presence in you?
2. What is one thing you would do this coming year to "come out and be separate" from this world?
3. What is one thing you would stop worrying about as you are reminded that you are God's son or daughter?
