SERMON OUTLINE

Crossing Over with God

Deuteronomy 31:3-8

Big Idea: God moves with His People

Key Verse: Deuteronomy 31:8 (NIV)

The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.

Introduction

- As the nation of Israel stood before the Promised Land, many dangers and obstacles stood in their way.
- God spoke to Joshua and the people not to give in to fear and doubt because of the circumstances and potential dangers.
- God Himself was crossing over ahead of them, and will be with them as they moved forward in faith.

Crossing Over with God means having:

1. God's Provision

- God moves ahead to prepare what His people needed to secure victory (Deut. 31: 3).
- God prepares what we need beforehand, as we move into a new season of life.

2. God's Promise

- Israel's entry into Canaan was not based on its own ambitions, but according to God's promise (Deut. 31:7).
- God's promises to His people never fail (Joshua 21:43-45, 2 Corinthians 1:20).

3. God's Presence

- God's presence with His people means that they will never be abandoned or forsaken (Deut. 31:8).
- Jesus promised His presence as we obey to live on mission for Him (Matthew 28:18-20).

Conclusion:

As we move into the new year, God has already gone ahead of us and will be with us as we live for Christ.

Reflection Questions:

1. How does the knowledge of God moving ahead of you in the new year help address your anxiety about the future?
2. What are some of the key promises in Bible that have been fulfilled in Christ? How are we to live in the light of this?
3. Jesus promised to be with us as we live on mission for Him (Matthew 28:18-20). How do we orientate our lives to live for Jesus?
