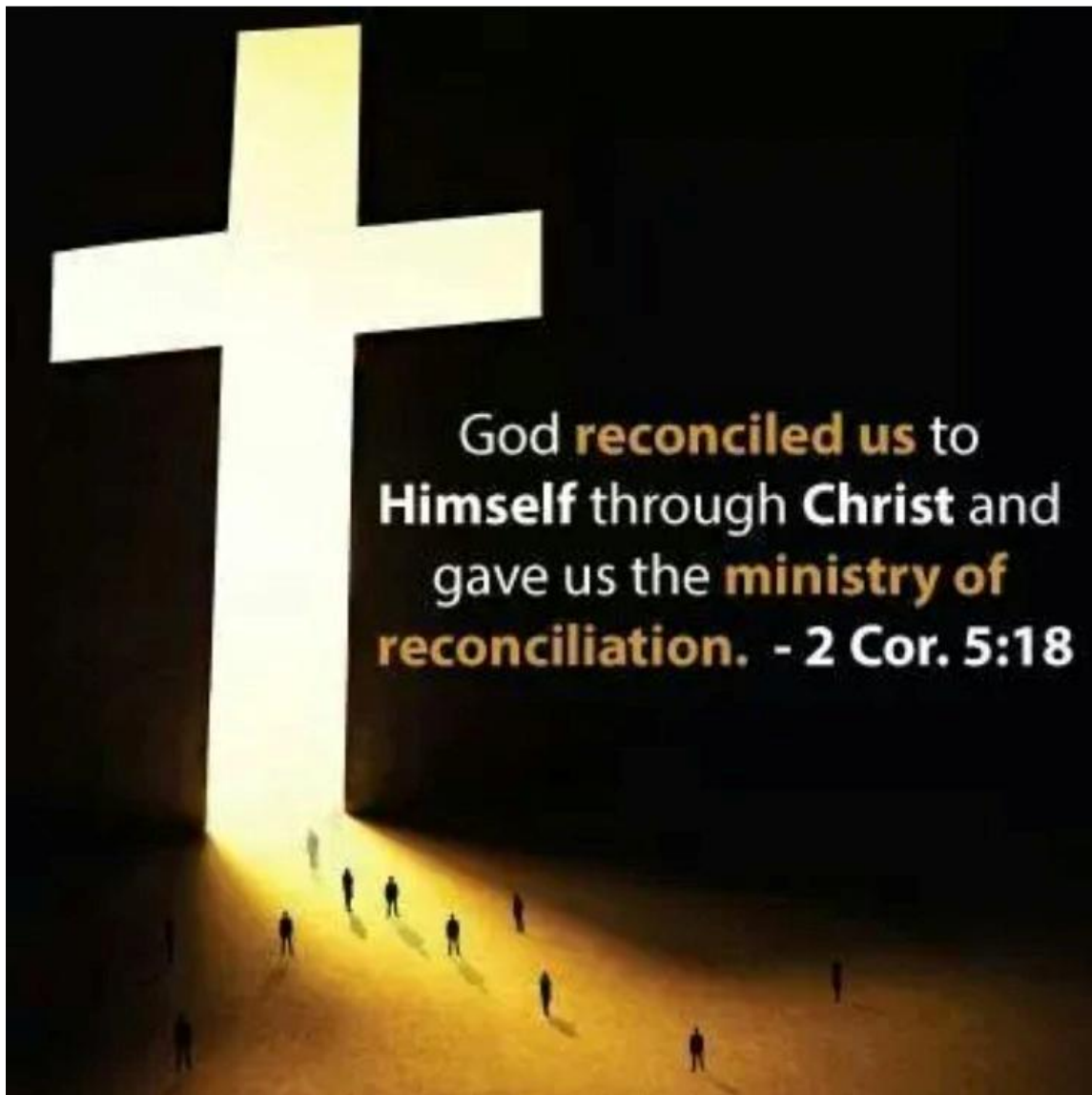

SERMON OUTLINE

Awareness of the Role We Have

2 Corinthians 5:11-21

BIG IDEA: We are ambassadors of Christ.

Key Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:20a (NIV)

We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us.

Introduction

- Paul recounts the core message of the Gospel of Christ to reconcile those who might have been opposed to him
- Having been reconciled to God, Christians are entrusted with the ministry of reconciliation (2 Cor 5:18)

Understanding our role in God's mission involves being:

1. Compelled by Christ (2 Cor 5:11-15)

- Fear of the Lord – being accountable to Christ with reverent awe and humble obedience to live a life pleasing to Him (see 2 Cor 5:9-10)
- Love of Christ – being constantly moved and compelled by the love Christ has for us
- Living for Christ, not self

2. Conformed to Christ (2 Cor 5:15-18)

- New perspectives and worldview
- New Creation

3. Commissioned for Christ (2 Cor 5:18-21)

- Entrusted with the ministry of reconciliation
- Being an ambassador of Christ
- Bringing God's appeal to the world

Conclusion:

We must live aware of the ministry of reconciliation entrusted to us.

1. What are the key motivations of my life and actions?
2. As God's New Creation in Christ, what is one perspective or worldview I must adopt toward others this week?
3. What is one thing I must do this week to live out my role as an ambassador of Christ?
