Engaging Families in Outreach

Acts 10:17-33

Notes:

Background - Who is Cornelius? Acts 10:1-6

- 1st century Roman centurion stationed in Caesarea
- Devout, prayerful and God-fearing man who gave alms generously
- Received a vision instructing him to send for Peter

Peter's Vision Acts 10:9-17

Key Lesson - do not call anything impure that God has made clean.

Cornelius had Fervent Faith - God-fearers were Gentiles who believed in the God of Israel; they were sympathetic to and supportive of the Jewish faith. They stopped short of becoming Jews in lifestyle and circumcision

Peter's Lessons

1. Learning God's Timing
2. Learning God's Purpose
3. Learning Obedience
4. Learning Wisdom
5. God used the Jew and the Gentile

Family and Friends

- The faith Cornelius had
- The risks he took
- His testimony

Fertile Field and Future Fellowship - the church from thence included the Gentiles

Summary:

- 2 people – 1 Gentile and 1 Jew, and God working through them to break social, cultural, and religious barriers
- Cornelius took great faith and risks to call his family and friends in anticipation of Peter's coming into his home
- The Church now includes the Gentiles

Conclusion:

KNOW: that God can use anyone for His purposes even under the most unthinkable of circumstances

BE: fervent in faith, prayerful and excelling in kindness and good deeds for God's glory

DO: your utmost to bring family and friends together whenever there are opportunities to hear the gospel

1. What challenges do you face when it comes to inviting family and friends to hear the gospel?
2. What can we learn about Cornelius's faith and personal risks that he took in reaching out to family and friends?
3. In what ways can your SG or church help and support your efforts to call your family and friends for pre/evangelistic meetings?
