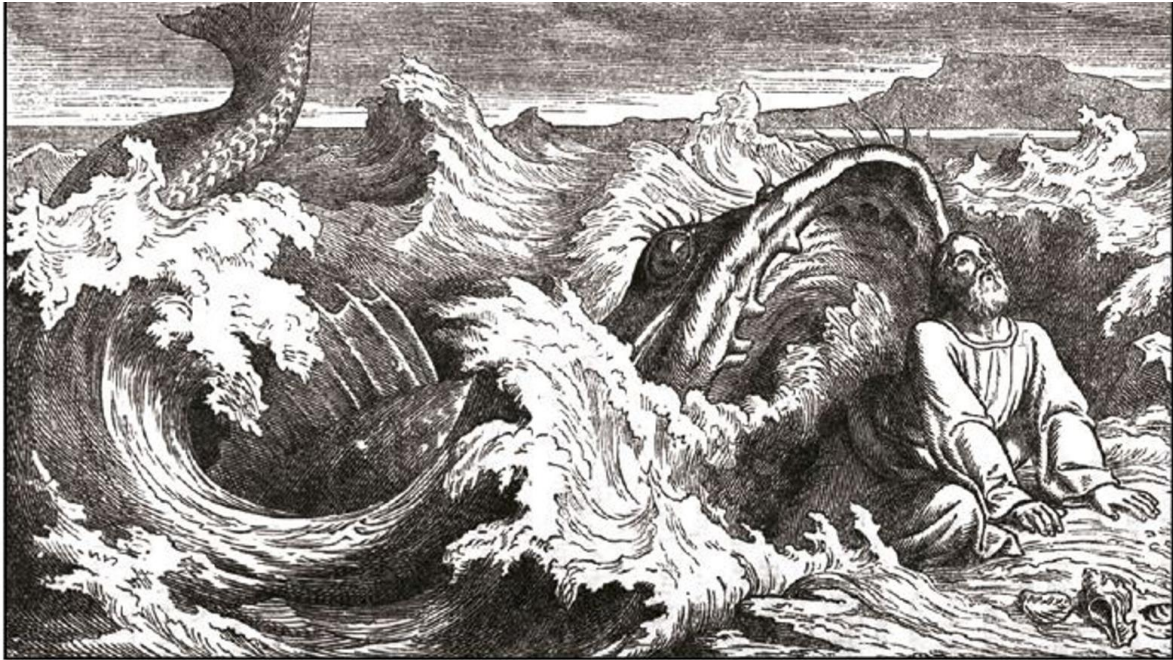

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: God Deals with Jonah's Reluctance

Scripture: Jonah 1:1-17

Requirement from God

Go! Preach against the city! Because of its wickedness

Introspection: What or Who is your Nineveh?

Reluctance / Refusal of Jonah

More than running away from Nineveh, Jonah fled 'from the Lord', away from His presence, to escape from 'The word of the Lord'

Introspection: What or Where is your Tarshish?

Reckoning from God

- Bad storm - tie down cargo; really bad storm - throw cargo overboard & pray
- The ones whose gods can do nothing is praying,
- The one whose God can do everything is sleeping.
- The sailors prayed to Jonah's God & sought forgiveness for killing Jonah
- First they feared the storm, then they feared the Lord!

Reined in by God

- When Jonah was thrown overboard, God remained merciful by providing a big fish to swallow him
- God restrained Jonah for 3 days/nights, allowed him to reflect, pray, repent and return to his role as prophet

Recovery of Jonah

- Given a second opportunity, Jonah obeyed and preached out against the evil of Nineveh
- From 3 days confined in the stomach of the fish to 3 days crossing Nineveh

Repentance of Nineveh

- The King and the people of Nineveh repented
- They fasted, covered themselves in sackcloth, called upon God for forgiveness

Relentment of God

- Hebrew root word for 'relent' is na-cham and also the root for "repented"
- It signifies a change of course, of becoming more compassionate and forgiving

Real Reason Jonah Ran

- Jonah deemed God's forgiveness on Nineveh to be very wrong?
- He was devastated not because he failed but because he was successful!
- He KNEW that God was full of grace and merciful and THAT was the reason he didn't want to go to Nineveh – IN CASE HE WAS SUCCESSFUL AND NINEVEH FORGIVEN!
- He ran to Tarshish to forestall, to delay what he knew to be inevitable
- So after ALL THIS, Jonah wants to die!
- God will deal with Jonah on this matter in Jonah 4

Closing Thoughts

- He learnt that God's grace and mercy extend to all, even the undeserving
- Many sailors (passengers?) were saved
- Jonah ran from God; the real reason was:
- Not fear of the Assyrians but hatred of them
- Not fear of failure but fear of success
- Not fear of death but that he might live

Summary

God's grace and mercies are boundless

You can run, but God 'will find you'...

God seeks to forgive than to judge

God can use flawed and broken people, even the reluctant for His purposes

Outward obedience hides the inward heart – but God knows our hearts

Conclusion

KNOW: that God can use us for His purposes even when our hearts are not aright at the time

BE: prepared for God's guidance in ways and through circumstances that may surprise you

DO: trust that God has your best interest in His heart when you respond to his word

Reflection and Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever ran away, hid behind busyness or excuses, or just ignored God's word to do something? How does God's dealing with Jonah change your future responses to His word? Share and discuss
2. God relented from judging Nineveh when they repented. Do you think this is just a reprieve or a respite or is it a full lasting forgiveness?
3. God still used Jonah despite harbouring hatred in his heart against the Assyrians. God relented and did not bring on Nineveh the destruction he had threatened. How does this change your response to His charge to us to share the gospel?
